Stoborough Nursery Admissions policy

We aim to make our nursery genuinely accessible to all children and their families and in order to do this, we will:

- 1. Welcome all children parents/carers and other relatives regardless of ethnic, religious and social backgrounds.
- 2. Accommodate children parents/carers and other relatives individual needs
- 3. Provide good communication between nursery and home setting.
- 4. Ensure that the existence of the nursery is widely known in all local communities
- 5. Allocate sessions in the following order; giving priority to those children who:

Already attend the nursery
Have siblings attending the nursery
Have siblings already attending Stoborough School
Live in the catchment for Stoborough School
Are on the waiting list
In order of date of birth

- Be flexible about attendance patterns and payment in order to accommodate the needs of individual children and families in accordance with the terms and conditions for Early learning and Childcare Funding.
- Make policies available to all.
- Consult with parents/carers to ensure that opening times are meeting the local need and the group stays current with the changing needs of the community.
